- Been diagnosed with Type 1 or Type 2 diabetes and have experienced signs or symptoms of painful Diabetic Peripheral Neuropathy (DPN) for at least 6 months
- Controlled your blood sugar levels for at least 3 months prior to enrolling in the study

Participation in this 5-month study requires 14 office visits and 1 follow-up phone call.

All study-related office visits, medical evaluations, and study medication for pain will be provided to qualified study participants at no cost.
